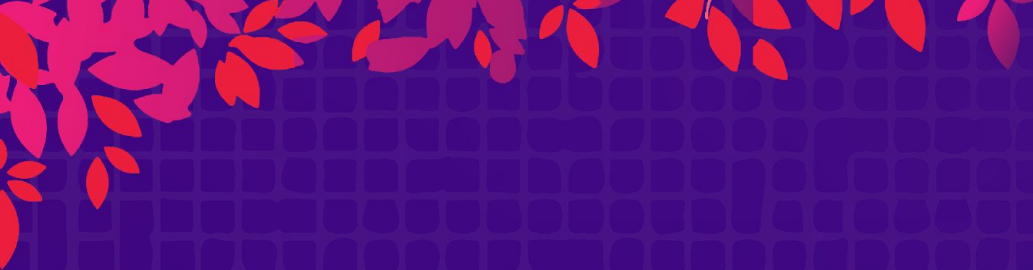

Scope

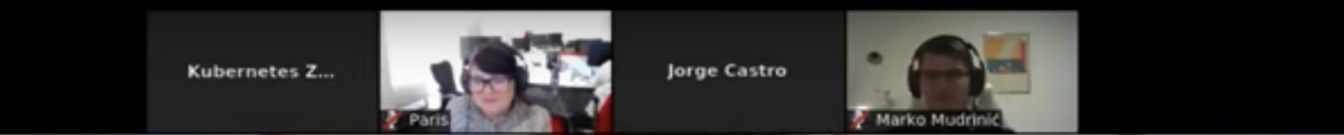
